HEADTEACHER'S FOREWORD

I am pleased to present the school's examination results for 2015.

This year our best set of results was at AS level where our students achieved the best grades in the school's history. Over 91% of the examinations were passed with 59% at grade C or above and 38% at B or above. Amy Hazelwood and Nancy Vu both received 4 A grades, Aimee Donhou and Bethan King gained 3 A grades and 1 B. Natasha Southgate, Ellie White and Courtney Morton all gained 2 A grades.


At A2 level our pass rate was 97% with 69% of grades at C or above and 35% at B and above. Emily Jobson gained an A* and 2 A grades, Gina Boot and Eloise Bones gained A*AB grades. Chloe Warrilow gained A*ABB and Danielle Cubitt-Brown, Holly Mallows & Katie Walford AAB grades.

GCSE results were disappointing overall by our high standards. Despite being above the provisional national and Havering averages, we did not match the excellent performance of 2014 with 60% gaining 5 A*-C grades including English and Maths this year. Results in the Cambridge iGCSE English examinations were far lower than expectations and resulted in us returning a number of papers to be remarked. Results in Maths also slightly dipped but remain significantly above local and national levels in terms of raw attainment and levels of progress. Overall 22 of our 27 subjects were above the national levels for A*-C and 15 above for A*/A. 16% of grades were judged A*/A.

Notable performances included: Nosayba Al Haj Hamad : 5A*, 4A, 2B & 1C; Victoria Bowler & Ekuia Arthur : 3A*, 7A & 1B; Grace Bunn : 5A*, 5A & 1B; Elissa Campbell-Douglas : 3A*, 4A & 2B; Anabelle Deeble : 4A*, 4A & 2B; Mia Gould : 3A*, 4A & 4B; Charlotte Harrington : 6A*, 4A & 1B; Lucy Houlston : 3A*, 7A & 1B; Rebeka Jabbar : 8A* & 3A; Erin Jones : 6A* & 5A; Emily Martin : 4A*, 6A & 1B and Rebecca Taffs : 3A*, 5A, 2B & 1C.

The main assessment of a school moving forward will be based on Maths and English GCSE results, attainment and progress in 8 subjects and progress in subjects will become even more significant. We will be working to ensure we address all these areas in the coming weeks.

As a school we know that good examination results are essential and I am proud that our students and staff work extremely hard to adapt to increasingly challenging and changing examination demands. I am also determined that we will continue to help students develop the values and attributes that will make them successful in the future.
