HEADTEACHER'S FOREWORD

I am delighted to introduce our examination results for 2016.


This year's results at GCSE level are the best for at least 5 years and, given the increased challenge of examinations and higher grade boundaries, represent some of the best results in the history of the school. Our **5A*-C with English and Maths percentage of 66%** is well above the average for the country and the local authority. It is an increase of 6% on last year. Results in Maths have been consistently good thanks to the work of Mr Gaya and his team. 74% of students gained a C grade or higher in Maths. English results this year have been similarly good at 75% A*-C. **Over 22% of all results were at A* or A grade.** The new government measure, Progress 8, which assesses how well students have done in 8 subjects taking into account their prior performance in Primary school, has given us a positive figure which shows that students, on average, did as would be expected here.

Notable performances at GCSE included:

At A level, our pass rate was 99.5%, a fantastic result for a comprehensive school. Almost **40% of the grades were A*-B**, an increase on last year. Nancy Vu gained an A* and 2 A grades and will study at Cambridge University, Catherine Fennell 2A*s and 1 B, Amy Hazelwood and Ellie White 3 A grades and Aimee Donhou and Bethan King 2 A grades and 1 B.

In the year when we were told by Ofsted that we continue to be a Good school, it is really pleasing to see that results have improved even further. I am proud of the commitment of our staff and students and the support of our parents and governors. Whilst examination results continue to be a vital part of school life, we continue to maintain an environment where students learn values and attributes, and have opportunities, that will help them be successful in the future.
