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Headteacher's Foreword

I am delighted to introduce our examination results for 2017.

This year's results at GCSE level are the best for at least 5 years and, given the increased challenge of examinations and higher grade boundaries, represent some of the best results in the history of the school. Our **5A*-C with English and Maths percentage of 69%** is well above the average for the country and the local authority. It is an increase of 3% on last year. Results in Maths at C, or now 4, and above have been consistently good thanks to the work of Mr Gaya and his team. 76% of students gained a C grade or higher in Maths. English results this year have been outstanding at 80% A*-C in language and 85% A*-C in literature. **Over 20% of all results were at A* or A grade.** The new government measure, Progress 8, which assesses how well students have done in 8 subjects taking into account their prior performance in Primary school, cannot be calculated until Government data is released at the end of September but our attainment in 2017 has exceeded that of 2016.

At A level, our pass rate was 96.4%, a strong result for a comprehensive school. **35% of the grades were A*-B.**
